- 運動員需符合 3 年居港期的規定
- 根據運動員過去兩年的成績表現作考慮 (即 2020 年 1 月 1 日至 2021 年 12 月 31 日)，請將成績連同申請表格一併遞交
- 有關項目的比賽必須最少有 4 個國家/地區參與，該成績才會獲得考慮
- 有關隊際比賽項目的全隊運動員必須是以香港代表身分參賽
- 全國錦標賽(National Championship) 只計全年總成績之排名 (得到頭三名及名列前 1/3 名次)，單場名次並不計算在內
- 必須由本會委任教練總監或本會註冊之二級教練推薦
- 所有獲得資助的運動員需每年呈交表現評核報告兩次，此報告將由教練填寫並由本會審批，若未能於限時內呈交，香港體育學院將暫緩或停止發放相關資助
- 所有遞交之申請由香港體育學院審批，本會及運動員對審批結果不得異議
- 運動員及所屬教練必須仔細參閱上述之評核準則

NOTES :

- Athletes receiving grants should meet the three-year residency policy;
- For the application, the past two-year performance would be taken into account (i.e. from 1-1-2020 to 31-12-2021);
- Only races including participation of at least 4 countries/zones would be considered;
- All team athletes involved in team competitions must be Hong Kong representatives
- The National Championship only consider the overall ranking of the year (the top 3 and the top 1/3), the single-match ranking will not be considered.
- All applications must be endorsed by HKAA's authorized Coach Director or registered Level 2 Coach;
- Performance appraisal reports for all grant recipients have to be submitted twice a year that will be completed by the applicant and processed by HKAA, failing which the grant will be temporarily suspended or stopped;
- HKSI reserves the rights of final decision; and HKAA and athletes have no right to object; and
- Athletes and Coaches must read carefully the eligibility criteria and guidelines.
